

Fermilab TARGET Program - Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

2018 program dates: June 25 through August 3, 2018

- **Can I apply as a freshman?**

At time of application, the student must be a Sophomore or Junior.

- **If accepted, will I be living onsite, or will I have to travel back home every day?**

The TARGET Program does not provide housing for interns. It is the intern's responsibility to commute to and from Fermilab.

- **Does Fermilab provide transportation?**

Bus transportation is provided to and from Fermilab only at the CTA Blue Line Forest Park terminal, for interns residing in the Chicago area.

- **What are the program hours?**

8am to 4pm.

- **How many hours will I work per week?**

Interns will work the morning hours (8am-12pm) with an assigned project supervisor—20 paid work hours per week—and do STEM & Leadership Workshops in the afternoons (unpaid).

- **If accepted, will I work and get paid on the Fourth of July?**

No, this is an Off Day (unpaid).
